First prize: \$200.00, Second prize: \$100.00.

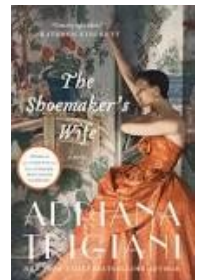


Best-selling NY Times Author, Adriana Trigiani to speak at the Spring Library Author Luncheon!
