

# YOUTH SERVICES NARRATIVE

JUNE 2016

With June came the start of this year's Summer Reading Program! I came in the first day of the program, Saturday, June 4<sup>th</sup>, from 10 am to 3 pm, to answer questions and get folks signed-up. And starting on the following Tuesday, I've been sitting out at the sign-up table on Tuesday and Friday mornings to answer questions about Summer Reading and answering research questions (readers advisory, finding items in the collection, etc.).

June is a big programming month, with 22 child programs, 3 YA programs, and 9 Family programs, with 206 adults, 421 children, and 33 teens attending the programs.

I've also been working on adding pages to the website, as well as keeping it up to date. I've added a Quick Links box to the footer, with links to some commonly-requested sites. I've also added more categories to the Beyond the Library page, to make it easier to navigate. I've created a GED resources page (under the Resources tab), as well as an Internet Help page, with resources about evaluating information from the internet. Maribeth has been sending me updated lists of new materials, so I can keep our new items pages as current as possible. I'm also working on a Solanco Literature Canon page, with information about the district's required books.
