Rideshare Overview

We maintain a confidential rideshare program of commuters traveling to worksites who want to share the ride. After we process your application, you will receive a list of other commuters who share the same travel pattern and schedule. It is up to you to contact someone on your list to start the carpool. Should you need further support, our staff can provide additional assistance.

Once you start using a green commute more than two times a week, you will be eligible for our Emergency Ride Home program.

Emergency Ride Home Program

Commuters who share the ride to work, use transit, walk, or bike have a common concern, "What do I do in an emergency?" That is why the Emergency Ride Home program is offered!

The free program is a reimbursement for a qualified emergency ride for commuters who use options other than commuting alone to work in their personal vehicles.
